



1. These Directions apply to licensed centres in Great Britain.
2. These Directions authorise the keeping, by or on behalf of a person to whom a licence applies, of:
 - (a) human admixed embryos; or
 - (b) gametes and embryos not intended for human application (research)in the course of their carriage to or from any premises.
3. These Directions authorise the keeping, by or on behalf of a person to whom a licence applies, of gametes or embryos intended for human application (treatment or storage for future use) in the course of carriage between:
 - (a) licensed premises,
 - (b) licensed premises and relevant third party premises,
 - (c) premises referred to in paragraphs (a) and (b) and tissue establishments in a third country, pursuant to Directions given under section 24 (4) of the Act.
